Document Description:

This query will produce a report of the average CUM GPA and average TERM GPA for all students that were ACTIVE in a student group for any past term.

NOTE: the cums are associated with the end of the desired term. Therefore, if you run this query for Spring, 2000, Summer 2000 grades will not be factored in. Also, the acad group of the students is also associated with the desired term. This does not necessarily reflect the student's current acad group.

Variable Limits on Query:

TERM: enter any past term. This will be associated with the term gpa AND the cum gpa. The cum gpa reported is as of the term, not what it is currently.

STUDENT GROUP: enter the student group CODE here.

EFFECTIVE DATE: You MUST enter a date that the student became active in that student group. To retrieve all students active in a group during the term you indicated, enter the LAST DAY of the indicated term. This will force your query to include all students active in the student group through the designated term. This date can be found in the Time Schedule of Classes for that term.

Limits on Query:

ENROLL STATUS > 0 EFFECTIVE STATUS = 'A' CAMPUS = (All Campuses are selected)

AVERAGE GPA REPORT: this is a breakdown of the number of students in student group by college, gender and level. The average CUM gpa and TERM gpa for each population is reported.
